Hello Paisa recently introduced banking features for its consumers on WhatsApp.

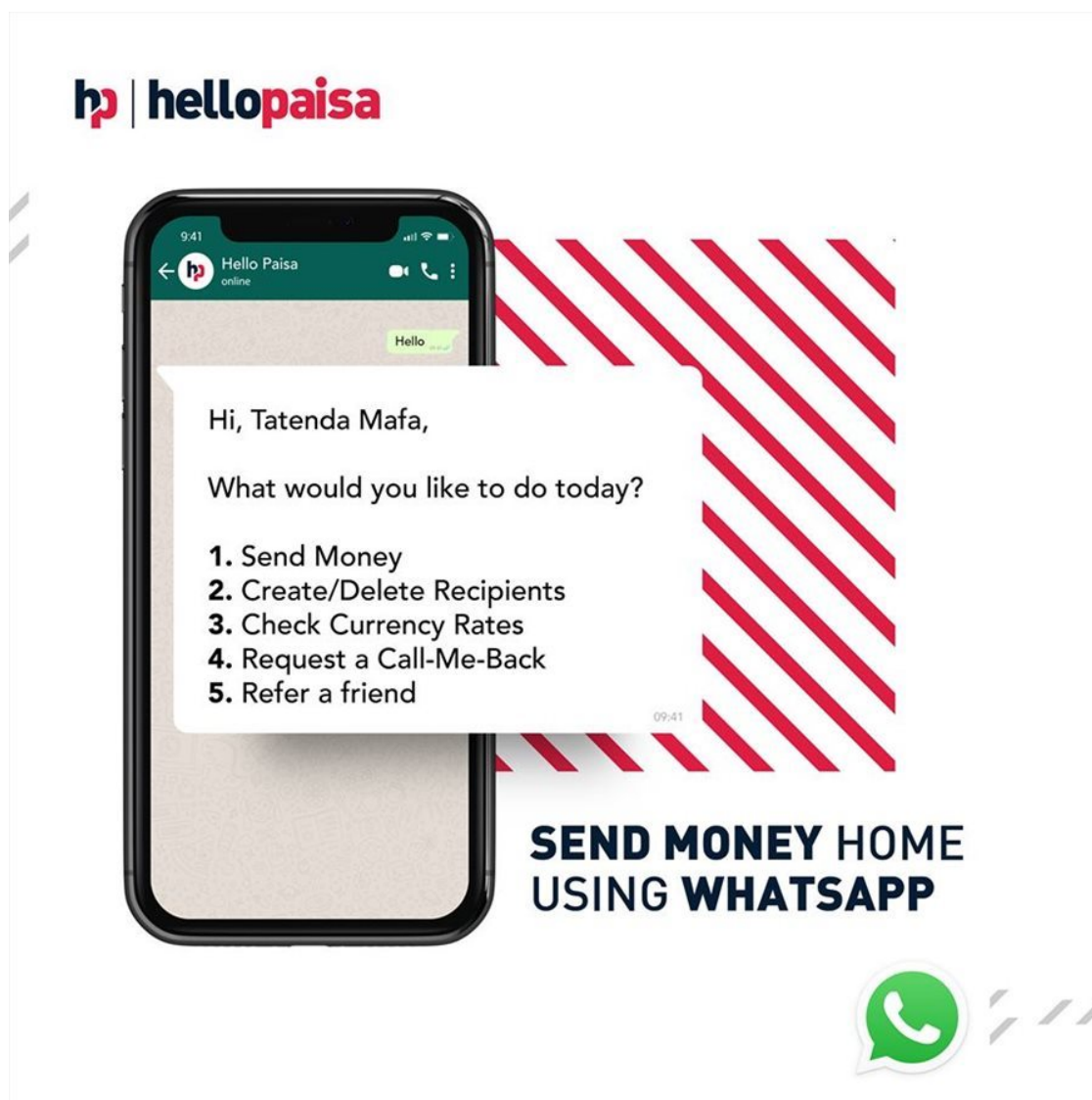
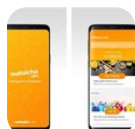
