Education has always been a cause close to Tata's heart and what better way to honour both his memory and his legacy."

As Back to School for a Day celebrates its fourth year, Adopt-a-School's chairperson, Cyril Ramaphosa, hopes its partnership with the NMF will result in more contributions being made to educating the country's future leaders: "One day of collective action can have a huge impact on our schools. It affirms the value that society places on the success of each pupil."
